Record Book Completion

- Record book questions are answered with complete sentences.
- Leave no blank spaces.

Neatness

- •Record book and story are readable and appealing.
- •Recor book free of erasures and crossed-out words.
- •Stories may be handwritten or typed.

Spelling & Punctuation

•Use correct spelling and punctuation.

Story Procedure

- Clearly identify what the project is.
- Describe how the project was made or achieved.
- •Include what you learned in your story, the more details the better.
- •Make sure story is orderly, factual and detailed.

Story Details

- Tell why the project was selected.
- •Tell who helped with the project and explain the importance of that help.

Story Construction

- •At least three paragraphs, including an introduction, body and conclusion.
- Have a catchy beginning that introduces the project or accomplishment.

Pictures

•Pictures that show you in the process of completing the project are important to include.
